

**May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2023**

Meeting will start at 8:00am. Any delegations wishing to address council will be required to contact the office the Friday prior to the meeting at the latest.

### Assessment Notices

2023 Assessment Notices were mailed out **April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023**.

Please note that revaluations on properties are done every four years. The last revaluation was done in **2021**. The next revaluation will be in **2025**.

Unless you have made significant changes to your property in the past year (ex. adding/removing a building, new subdivision, etc.), **you will not receive an Assessment Notice until 2025**.

The Assessment Notice is the official notice of the assessed value of your property as determined by SAMA. Your Assessment Notice will have the appeal form on the back of the sheet. The deadline to appeal your assessment is **May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023**. This notice and time-frame is the only opportunity for appealing assessments during the year. If you disagree with the property value established by SAMA, there is a formal appeal process available to you. Appeals must be based on an error in your property assessment and not based on the amount of taxes paid for the property. Appeal fees will apply. Property reports may be viewed on the SAMA website. Please check our website or Facebook page for important resources.

### Tax Notices

2023 Taxes will be levied in **June**. Taxes are due on or before **December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023**. A discount of **6%** on the municipal portion of taxes is offered for payments made by **July 31<sup>st</sup>**, **4%** by **August 31<sup>st</sup>**, and **2%** by **September 30<sup>th</sup>**. All payments must be received or the envelope date stamped by Canada Post on or before the last day of the month.

### Transfer Station

March – October hours are in effect. The Aberdeen Transfer Station is open Wednesdays and Saturdays from **10:00am until 5:00pm**. ### Custom Work

Custom Work is available to ratepayers in the RM of Aberdeen for snow removal, driveway grading and land leveling. A Work Authorization Form is required prior to any work being done by the RM. Please contact the office or visit our website for more information.

**Elevators** \$175.00/hr + PST (min \$90.00 before tax)  
**Developers** \$225.00/hr + PST (min \$115.00 before tax)

### Controlled Burn

The RM Council would like to remind everyone to take extreme caution while having a controlled burn. Do not forget to register your burns:

1. Register with the Municipality: call **306-253-4312** or **306-230-1603** (Adrien Hamoline – Fire Chief) after hours and weekends.
2. Register with the Provincial Fire Center at **1-866-404-4911**.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, you will be fined **\$1000**. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighbouring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have proper Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

### Emergency Services

In case of an emergency, please call **911**. Ensure that you are familiar with your Civic Address and Land Location in order to aid the emergency services in a quick response time to your location.

### Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired permits must be closed in a timely manner. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM Office. Call or text Nicole at BuildTECH Inspections at **306-370-2824** to book your inspection.

### Animals Roaming at Large

Keeping animals within your property is the responsibility of the owner. If your animals are roaming within the RM, steps will be taken to detain the animals and all costs incurred in doing so will be the responsibility of the animals' owner.

### Pest Control Officer

If you suspect a rat infestation on your property or on a neighbouring property, please call Denis at **306-220-8996**. Denis is conducting site visits and will be going around to all yard sites doing inspections. Rat poison can be picked up at the office during regular business hours.

This 3-page form is not required for unheated detached garages or sheds.

## Building Permits

**Are required prior to construction of;**

All New Dwellings, Garage, Sheds – 100 sq ft & over (10x10 or larger), Decks, Additions, Basement Development, Structural changes to existing buildings.

## Building Permits

**Are required prior to installation of solar panels on existing roof structures**

**Introduction**

The Water Security Agency (WSA) requires that at least once each year waterworks owners provide notification to consumers of the quality of water produced and supplied as well as information on the performance of the waterworks in submitting samples as required by a Permit to Operate a waterworks. The following is a summary of the Town of Aberdeen water quality and sample submission compliance record for the Jan.1<sup>st</sup> to Dec.31<sup>st</sup> 2022 time period. This report was completed on March 31, 2023. Readers should refer to the Agency's Municipal Drinking Water Quality Monitoring Guidelines, November 2002, EPB 202 for more information on minimum sample submission requirements and the meaning of type of sample. *A minimum of 0.1 milligrams per litre (mg/L) free chlorine residual is required for water entering the distribution system. Tests are normally performed on a daily basis by the waterworks operator and are to be recorded in operation records. This data includes the number of free chlorine residual tests performed, the overall range of free chlorine residual (highest and lowest recorded values) and the number of tests and percentage of results not meeting the minimum requirement of 0.1 mg/L free chlorine residual. Water is supplied by the City of Saskatoon and is chloraminated so there is rarely a free chlorine residual. The system operates on total chlorine residual.*

The General Chemical category includes analysis for alkalinity, bicarbonate, calcium, carbonate, chloride, conductivity, hardness (as CaCO<sub>3</sub>), magnesium, sodium, sulphate and total dissolved solids.




