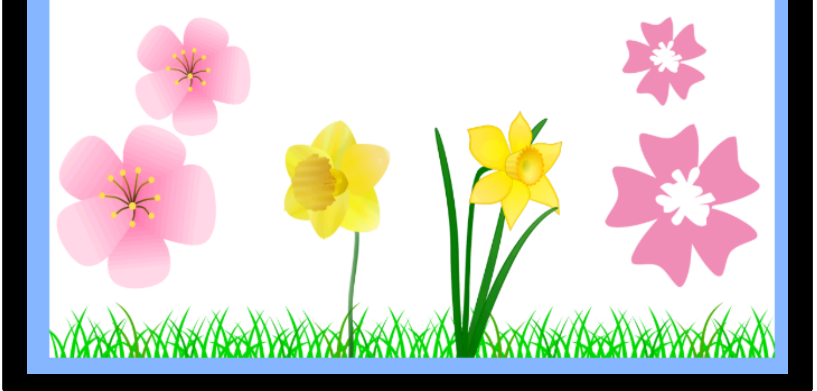

Assessment Notices:

Assessment Notices will be mailed out this month.

Please note that revaluations on properties are done every four years. The last revaluation was done in **2025**. The next revaluation will be in **2029**. Unless you've made changes to your property (new subdivision, adding/removing a building, new ownership), you will not receive an Assessment Notice until 2029.

The Assessment Notice is the official notice of the assessed value of your property as determined by the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA). Your Assessment Notice has the appeal form on the back of the sheet as well as the deadline for appeal. This notice and time-frame is the **only** opportunity for appealing assessments during the year.

The information contained on your Assessment Notice is used in conjunction with annual Mill Rates to determine your taxes for the year. You **cannot** appeal your taxes. You can, however, appeal the assessment upon which your taxes are based.

Pest Control:

The RM's appointed Pest Control Officer is Denis Boyenko. Denis conducts site visits throughout the spring and summer months. Please report rat infestations to Denis directly at **306-220-8996**.

Gravel:

If you believe you have gravel on your property, and would be willing to let the RM conduct testing for it, please reach out to the RM Office for details.

Transfer Station:

Ratepayers in the RM of Aberdeen have access to two Transfer Stations:

Aberdeen Transfer Station:

Wednesdays and Saturdays from **10:00am to 5:00pm**

Blucher Transfer Station:

Tuesdays and Thursdays from **2:00pm to 7:00pm** and
Saturdays from **9:00am to 5:00pm**

User cards are required to utilize the Transfer Stations. If you do not have a current Transfer Station user card, please contact the office at **306-253-4312** or through email to rm373@sasktel.net. Cards can be mailed out or picked up in person.

You must have your card with you to access either Transfer Station.

Building Permits:

All structures or buildings over **100ft²** require a building permit. Houses or additions require permits regardless of their square footage.

All buildings must adhere to the setbacks in our Zoning Bylaw. The zoning of your property will determine the required setbacks.

- Site Plan
- Building Plans
- \$100 Permit Application Fee
- SaskHealth Sewage Permit Number
- Energy Efficiency Compliance Form
- Checklist

COUNCIL'S CORNER

Town Council meetings are open to the public.

Council meetings are held at the TOWN OF ABERDEEN Office Chambers, 401C Main Street, at 7:00 pm every 3rd Tuesday of the Month.

Our next council meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 21st, 2026.

Any Delegations wishing to address Council are required to complete a Delegations Policy form and have it submitted to the Town Office no later than the Thursday prior to Council meeting date. You may obtain these from the Town Office. These forms are also available on our website www.aberdeen.ca

Spring Runoff FLOOD PREVENTION

The Town of Aberdeen is once again preparing for the start of the spring melt by ensuring the ditches are cleared, culverts are thawed and snow is placed accordingly to ensure proper run off.

However, this year a large amount of snow has been founded pushed onto streets, ditches, culverts and other municipal property. Please note, in accordance with Bylaw # 03-13, section (1), "No person shall place any snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction, swept or cleaned from private property onto any street, sidewalk, lane, ditch, drain or sewer."

To ensure proper drainage is maintained and infrastructure, such as culverts, are not damaged, Bylaw Enforcement will be acting on section (3) of Bylaw # 03-13 and enforcing penalties for those found guilty of the offence.

2026 Assessment Notices

Every four years the provincial government mandates SAMA (the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency) to conduct revaluations of all Saskatchewan properties to coincide with the change to a new base date (the legislated date to which the assessed values are related). The assessed values will be updated to reflect a base date of January 1, 2023. This means that the 2025 assessment reflects the property's value at this time.

This year, only the properties who have an assessment change or new ownership will receive assessment notices in the mail. The assessment roll has been prepared and is open for inspection until May 4, 2026.

Once you have received your assessment notice you have the right to appeal should there be an error found. There is a 60-day window in which a property owner can make an appeal. Please watch for upcoming announcements. SAMA provides detailed property information online through SAMAVIEW. It is a service provided to the public to access, search and compare individual property assessments and is free of charge to all users. 2026 MONTHLY TAX DISCOUNTS / PENALTIES:

For prompt payment of 2025 taxes the following discounts are allowed:

- Payments received in January 6.5% discount
- Payments received in February 5.5% discount
- Payments received in March 4% discount
- Payments received in April 3% discount
- Payments received in May 2% discount
- Payments received in June 1% discount
- Payments received in July .5% discount



Penalties for 2025 Tax arrears will be as follows:

August 1 (compounded monthly)	1%
September 1	1%
October 1	1%
November 1	1%
December 1	1%
On January 1, 2026 a 12% penalty will be applied to 2025 arrears	

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

2026 Tax Notices will be sent mid May/ beginning of June, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.

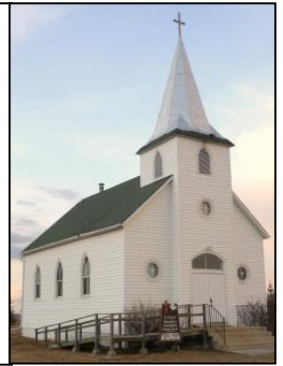
