#### Plowing Snow

We would like to remind everyone that plowing snow onto or across municipal right-of-way is not a permitted practice. Guilty parties will be subject to fines.

#### Garbage & Recycling Bins

If you have a rollout cart for garbage pickup, please remember to move your cart back onto your property after garbage day. Garbage carts left on the road or municipal right-of-way pose a hazard to motorists and <u>snow plow</u> machinery. Our road crew cannot fully clear roads if there are obstacles on the roadway after scheduled garbage pickup. Carts damaged by passing vehicles are the sole responsibility of the owner.

#### Controlled Burn

The RM Council would like to remind everyone to take extreme caution while having a controlled burn. Do not forget to register your burns: 1. Register with the Municipality: call **306-253-4312** or **306-230-1603** (Adrien Hamoline – Fire Chief) after hours and weekends. 2. Register with the Provincial Fire Center at **1-866-404-4911**.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, you will be fined **\$1000**. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighbouring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have proper Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

#### <u>Saskatchewan Municipal Hail Insurance</u>

Owners of land may withdraw all, but not part, of their cultivated land from the operations of the Municipal Hail Insurance Act by filing a withdrawal application with the Association on or before **March 31st**, **2023**. #### **Building Permits**

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired permits must be closed in a timely manner. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM Office. #### BYLAW # 03-13

#### A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ABERDEEN TO PROVIDE FOR THE <u>REMOVAL OF SNOW</u>, ICE AND OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS FROM STREETS, SIDEWALKS, LANE, DITCH, DRAIN OR SEWER

WHEREAS Section 8 of the Municipalities Act provides, in part, as follows:

"8(1) A municipality has a general power to pass any bylaws for the purposes of the municipality that it considers expedient in relation to the following matters respecting the municipality:

(b) the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property;


(g) streets and roads; including temporary and permanent openings and closings."

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Aberdeen in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

 No person shall place any snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction, swept or cleaned from private property onto any street, sidewalk, lane, ditch, drain or sewer.

2. The Public Works Department of the Town of Aberdeen shall have the authority to request any owner or occupant of property, within the municipality, to remove any vehicles as defined in *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997* for the purpose of removing snow, ice, or debris on any street, sidewalk or lane. Owners or occupants will be given twenty-four (24) hours notice for removal of all vehicles or the said vehicles will be removed by the municipality at the owners/occupants' expense.

3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and on summary conviction shall be liable to pay a penalty of not less than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00), as well as any costs incurred by the municipality to have said snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction removed.


