

Next Council Meeting May 12th, 2022

The May Council meeting will be held, the First Thursday of the month. Meetings will start at 8:00 am. Any delegations wishing to address the council will be required to contact the office by the Friday prior to the meeting.

Spring Weight Restrictions

The Spring Road Restrictions went into effect on March 28th, 2022. Any costs incurred to repair damaged roads will be charged back to anyone caught damaging the municipal roads. Be advised that Drews Rd, Old 27 Rd, and Bettker Rd all have 10-ton limits. Taxes/ Outstanding Invoices

2021 taxes were due by December 31, 2021. All outstanding taxes began collecting a penalty of 1% per month.

Pest Control Officer

If you suspect a rat infestation on your property or on a neighbouring property, please call Denis, at 306-220-8996. Denis is conducting site visits and will be going around to all yard sites doing inspections. Rat poison is available at the office during regular business hours.

Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date of issue. If a permit extension is required, please submit your request in writing to the RM office.

It is the responsibility of the landowner to ensure that inspections are completed, as per the review plan and that Building Permits are closed in a timely manner.

Don't forget to register your Controlled Burns

- Register with the municipality: call 306-253-4312 or 306-230-1603 after hours and weekends.
- Register with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, you will be fined \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs incurred will be charged to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have adequate Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

Taxes

2022 Taxes will be levied in June/July 2022. Taxes are due on or before December 31, 2022. A discount of 6% on the municipal portion is offered for payment in July, 5% in August, etc.; no discount is offered in December. All payments must be received or the envelope date stamped by Canada Post on or before the last day of the month.

In order for Voyent Alert to work effectively we need more residents to sign up. Currently we have 190 people participating (some of which are from the same household, which is great), 30 are still unknown to us (have signed up anonymously). We need to know who you are. Of the 285 homes & businesses 116 are signed up, this leaves us with 169 properties where we would have to go door to door in case of emergency (which can take a number of hours). The Voyent Alert sends out a notification of emergency in seconds.

PLEASE for everyone's safety consider registering. The Voyent Alert app will say "you are subscribed to receive notifications from the Town of Aberdeen using this app" but

please go into the menu and look under profile to see if your name is there. If your name is not there, please add it. This step is why we have so many anonymous. Thanks

2022 Business Licenses

According to Bylaw 12/14 the Business License Bylaw, all Home Based, Store Front and Contractor Business Licenses for 2021 are due December 31, 2021, and are valid until December 31, 2022.

License fees:

Home Based Business \$25 annually

Store Front Business \$75 annually

Contractor \$100 annually

General Contractor \$300 (covers the trades, as part of the building

The offence for conducting business without a Business License is \$200. Bylaw Enforcement will be issuing fines for non-compliance.

Business Application Forms can be found on our website www.aberdeen.ca under the business bylaw, fees can be paid by cheque, cash, e-transfer or by eft

According to Bylaw 03/22 Tax Tool Bylaw

2022 Property Taxes will be increasing by \$100 and will affect the land base tax portion for all residential and commercial properties (up from \$550 to \$650), with the base tax for improvements remaining at \$500 per property. School Div. Millrates increased for Residential from 4.46 to 4.54, Commercial from 6.75 to 6.86 and Agriculture from 1.36 to 1.42 mills.

History of the Base/Minimum Taxes in Aberdeen

The Town of Aberdeen began implementing minimum/base taxes dating back to the 1990's. The Provincial Government authorized the use of Tax Tools as a method to collect taxes in combinations with the millrate and minimum/base tax uses. Without a base tax the millrate would be higher and the belief is that regardless of how much value your property has, everyone has equal access to services provided by the Town of Aberdeen and therefore should be taxed evenly. Some of these universal/common services consist of Fire & Policing services, Recreation, Streets, Utilities, Library, Waste disposal, etc. So, by using the base tax (2022 Base tax will be \$650 on land, and \$500 on buildings) as a building block, then adding your taxable assessment X 6.75 (millrate) divided by 1000 results in your total Municipal portion of property taxes. The current taxable portion of residential is 80% and commercial 85% of your Assessed value of the land and buildings combined. In 2021 Tax Levy totals \$684,164.59, over \$300,000 made up the base tax portion.






