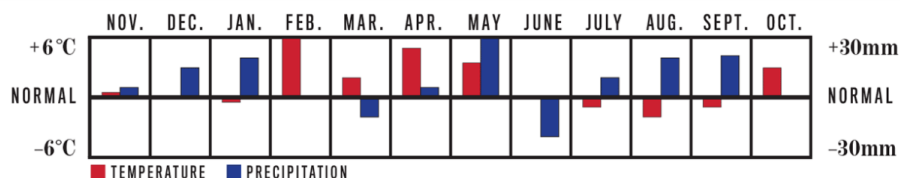

### **Next Council Meeting**

**January 13, 2022**

Council meetings are held the second Thursday of the month, unless changed by council. Meeting will start at 8:00 am. Council Meetings are open to public observation. Any delegations wishing to address the council will be required to contact the office the Friday prior to the meeting at the latest.

### **Taxes**

2021 taxes were due on or before December 31, 2021. As of January 1<sup>st</sup>, all outstanding taxes will begin collecting a penalty of 1% per month. All payments must be received on the envelope date stamped by Canada Post on or before December 31<sup>st</sup> to avoid penalty charges. All outstanding invoices from 2021 will be added to the taxes as arrears and will begin to accumulate penalty charges. Credit card payments now accepted on the RM website.

### **Plowing Snow**

We would like to remind everyone that plowing snow onto or across municipal right-of-way is NOT a permitted practice. Guilty Parties will be subject to Fines. Plowing snow across the roadways creates ridges that settle and harden, creating serious hazards to motorists, grader operators, and potential damage to graders.



### **Animals Roaming at Large**

Keeping animals within your property is the responsibility of the owner. If your animals are roaming within the RM, steps can be taken to detain the animals and all costs incurred in doing so will be the responsibility of the animals' owner.

1. Register with the municipality: call 306-253-4312 or 306-230-1603 after hours and weekends.
2. Register with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have proper Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

### **Building Permits**

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired permits must be closed in a timely manner. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM office. Call or Text BuildTECH Inspections at 306-370-2824 to book your inspection.

### **Pest Control Officer**

As the weather turns colder, rats will be looking for a warm place to stay and a steady source of food. If you suspect a rat infestation on your property or on a neighbouring property, please call Denis, at 306-220-8996. Denis is conducting site visits and will be going around to all yard sites doing inspections. Rat poison can be picked up at the office during regular business hours.

All unpaid Invoices as of December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021 will be applied to your tax account as arrears and are subject to a penalty of 1% per month.

**THANK YOU:** With the financial aid provided by the Government of Saskatchewan, the Town of Aberdeen received a Traffic Calming Grant in the amount of \$17,068, through the PSE Program-Provincial Traffic Safety Fund sponsored by SGI. We installed some traffic calming measures to improve safety and slow the traffic in our town. We did this by installing the traffic Logix Solar Evolution 12FM Radar signs at the entrances to our town. We installed radar signs at our 3 main intersections coming into town. We also installed Flashing-Blinker Stop Signs at the corner of 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Thompson Street.

## 2022 Business Licenses

According to Bylaw 12/14 the Business License Bylaw, all Home Based, Store Front and Contractor Business Licenses for 2021 are due December 31, 2021, and are valid until December 31, 2022.

### License fees:

Home Based Business \$25 annually

Store Front Business \$75 annually

Contractor \$100 annually

General Contractor \$300 (covers the trades, as part of the building permit)

The offence for conducting business without a Business License is \$200. Bylaw Enforcement will be issuing fines for non-compliance.

Business Application Forms can be found on our website [www.aberdeen.ca](http://www.aberdeen.ca) under the business bylaw, fees can be paid by cheque, cash, e-transfer or by eft

In order for Voyent Alert to work effectively we need more residents to sign up. Currently we have 161 people participating (some of which are from the same household) which is great, 39 are still unknown to us (have signed up anonymously). We need to know who you are. Of the 285 homes & businesses this potentially leaves us with 200 properties where we would have to go door to door in case of emergency (which can take a number of hours). The Voyent Alert sends out a notification of emergency in seconds.

PLEASE for everyone's safety consider registering.

The Voyent Alert app will say "you are subscribed to receive notifications from the Town of Aberdeen using this app" but please go into the menu and look under profile to see if your name is there. If your name is not there, please add it. This step is why we have so many anonymous.

December 1	1%
<b>On January 1, 2022 a 12% penalty will be applied to 2020 arrears</b>	

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

Tax Estimate Notices for 2022 taxes will be sent in December 2021. 2022 Tax Notices will be sent mid May, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.

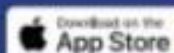

# ABERDEEN AND DISTRICT FIRE AND RESCUE

## A few winter safety tips from your local fire department...

- Never leave burning candles and plugged in electric heaters unsupervised
- Check furnace filter monthly & replace filters as needed
- Never store flammable products around furnace or hot water tank.
- Ensure energy efficient furnace vents are not obstructed by any objects. Intake vents should be checked weekly for ice buildup.
- Only use clean well-seasoned (1-year) wood in wood burning stoves and fireplaces.
- Check and clean chimney regularly as needed.
- Test smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors monthly – push the test button.
- Electric heater - Check for broken insulation/cracked wiring.
- Keep live Christmas trees well-watered to prevent drying out; turn off Christmas lights before leaving home or going to bed.
- Smoke alarm and carbon monoxide batteries should be replaced yearly.
  - Smoke alarms should be replaced every 5 years
  - Carbon monoxide alarms replaced every 10 years or as per label on pkg.
- Check fire extinguisher for expiration date or low pressure.
- Talk to your local fire fighters with any questions

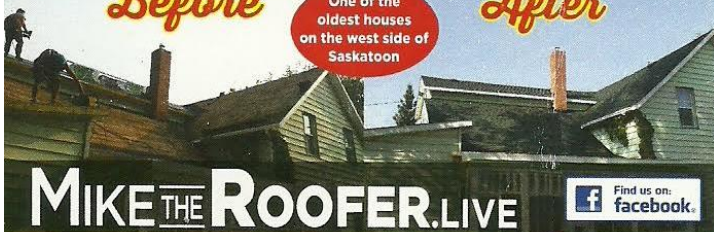
