## Assessment Notices:

Revaluations on properties are done every four years, making 2025 a revaluation year. This means all property owners will receive an Assessment Notice this year. **Assessment Notices were mailed out March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025.**

**The deadline for appeals is May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025.**

The Assessment Notice is the official notice of the assessed value of your property as determined by the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA). Your Assessment Notice has the appeal form on the back of the sheet as well as the deadline for appeal. This notice and time-frame is the **only** opportunity for appealing assessments during the year.

The information contained on your Assessment Notice is used in conjunction with annual Mill Rates to determine your taxes for the year. You **cannot** appeal your taxes. You can, however, appeal the assessment upon which your taxes are based.

## Bylaw Beat:

**Bylaw No. 2024-03: A Bylaw to Manage Fire Suppression Services** outlines the process for calling in a controlled burn and the penalties for failing to do so. If you live in a country residential development, please note this process is different.

## Transfer Station:

Ratepayers in the RM of Aberdeen have access to two Transfer Stations:

### Aberdeen Transfer Station:

Wednesdays and Saturdays from **10:00am to 5:00pm** (*March-October*)  
Wednesdays and Saturdays from 10:00am to 4:00pm (*November-February*)

### Blucher Transfer Station:

Tuesdays and Thursdays from **2:00pm to 7:00pm** and  
Saturdays from **9:00am to 5:00pm**

User cards are required to utilize the Transfer Stations. If you do not have a current Transfer Station user card, please contact the office at **306-253-4312** or through email to [rm373@sasktel.net](mailto:rm373@sasktel.net). Cards can be mailed out or picked up in person.

You must have your card with you to access either Transfer Station.

## Building Permits:

All structures or buildings over **100ft<sup>2</sup>** require a building permit. Houses or additions require permits regardless of their square footage. All buildings must adhere to the setbacks in our Zoning Bylaw. The zoning of your property will determine the required setbacks.

- Completed Building Permit Application Form
- Site Plan
- Building Plans
- \$100 Permit Application Fee
- SaskHealth Sewage Permit Number
- Energy Efficiency Compliance Form
- Checklist

## Cemetery:

The RM is responsible for maintaining the records of the Aberdeen Cemetery.

Grave plots are **10' x 10'**.  
Each 10' x 10' can be divided into two 5' x 10' plots.

5' x 10' plot: **\$200**

Columbarium niches are **12.5" x 12.5" x 14"**.

Each niche is designed to hold two urns.

Columbarium niche: **\$1000**  
(incl. cost of name & date plaques)

## When is a Building Permit required?

---

All new buildings and additions greater than 100 square feet in building area, are required to submit a permit. Building permits are required prior to the construction of all new dwellings, garages, sheds over 100sq feet, decks, additions, basement developments or structural changes to existing buildings.

## 2025 SAMA Revaluation

---

Every four years the provincial government mandates SAMA (the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency) to conduct revaluations of all Saskatchewan properties. This means that the 2025 assessment reflects the property's value at this time. As such, all properties within the Town of Aberdeen received an Assessment Notice.

**Assessment notices were mailed April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2025.**

Once you have received your assessment notice you have the right to appeal should there be an error found. There is a 60-day window in which a property owner can make an appeal. SAMA provides detailed property information online through SAMAVIEW. It is a service provided to the public to access, search and compare individual property assessments and is free of charge to all users.

**The final date to appeal your assessment notice is June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025.**

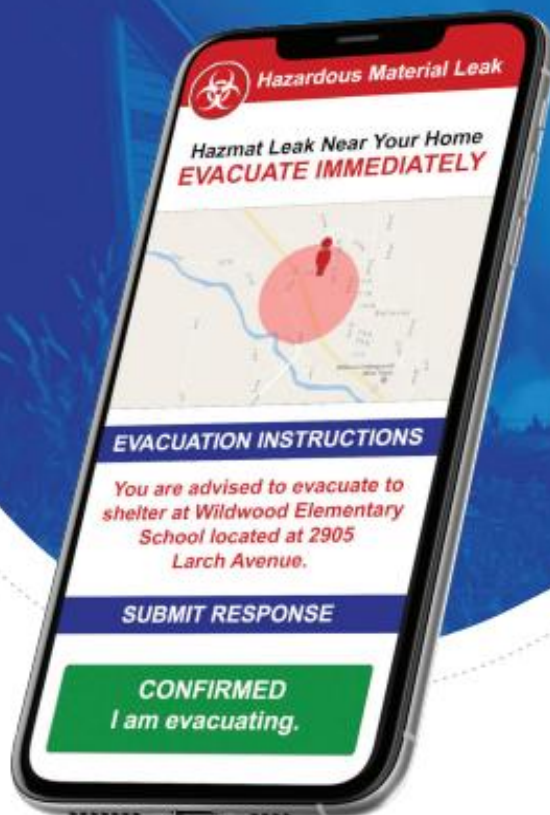
