Custom Work:

The 2026 Rates have been set as follows:

Ratepayers:
\$200/hr + PST (min \$100 before tax)

Elevators:
\$200/hr + PST (min \$100 before tax)

Developers:
\$250/hr + PST (min \$125 before tax)

During the winter months, snow clearing is a custom work service provided by the RM at the rates listed above.

Please visit our website for more information, including the Custom Work Authorization form that must be filled out prior to the RM doing any work.

School Tax Declaration:

If, for the 2026 Tax Notices:

1. You are an undeclared property owner who wishes to declare Separate School support;
2. You are a previously declared Separate School supporter who wishes to declare Public School support;
3. You are a previously declared Public School supporter who wishes to declare Separate School support, or;
4. A property is sold under a bona fide Agreement for Sale.

Please fill out the School Tax Declaration Form and submit to the RM Office by **February 28th, 2026**. Taxes are automatically paid to the Public School, unless changed through submission of the aforementioned form.

Saskatchewan Municipal Hail Insurance:

Owners of land may withdraw all, but not part, of their cultivated land from the operations of the Municipal Hail Insurance Act by filing a withdrawal application with the Association on or before **March 31st, 2026**. Withdrawal forms may be obtained from the RM Office or found on our website.

Loraas Pick-up:

If you have a roll-out cart for Loraas pickup, please remember to move your cart back onto your property after garbage day. Carts left on the road or municipal right-of-way pose a hazard to motorists and snow plow machinery. Carts damaged by passing vehicles are the sole responsibility of the owner.

Policy Post:

The RM of Aberdeen has an **Extreme Weather Policy** in place.

We recognize the hazards extreme weather pose to Municipal employees and equipment. The purpose of this policy is to establish measures to ensure the protection of the Municipal employees and equipment and reduce the risk of worker injury/damage to equipment from the hazards of working in extreme cold conditions.

During the winter months, Municipal equipment shall not be operated at temperatures in which the daytime high is less than -30°C or when the wind chill factor is in excess of -35°C. This will be at the Foreman's discretion and/or Council's discretion.

The following exceptions will be permitted:

In cases of emergency when determined by the Foreman or Council.

Gravel:

If you believe you have gravel on your property, and would be willing to let the RM conduct testing for it, please reach out to the RM Office for details.

2026 Business Licenses

According to Bylaw 12/14 the Business License Bylaw, all Home Based, Store Front and Contractor Business Licenses for 2026 were due December 31, 2025, and are valid until December 31, 2026.

License fees:

Home Based Business \$25 annually

Store Front Business \$75 annually

Contractor \$100 annually

General Contractor \$300 (covers the trades, as part of the building permit)

The offence for conducting business without a Business License is \$200. Bylaw Enforcement will be issuing fines for non-compliance.



Without more use of this system, there may be implications for the continued use of Voyent.

We are reaching out to all residents to encourage sign up of this program to ensure continuation of Voyent Alert.

BYLAW INFRACTIONS

Have you noticed a Bylaw Violation within the community and want to report it to the office?

Please go to <https://aberdeen.ca/p/bylaws> and click on Complaint Form. Once filled out and completed, drop off or email to the Town Office. This form will be given to our Bylaw Enforcement Officer and the necessary steps will be taken to rectify the situation.

You may wonder why these forms are needed and why a simple email or call to the office isn't sufficient...

These forms provide the necessary documentation and evidence to enforce our Bylaws. They are also used in court should the violation require prosecution.

2026 MONTHLY TAX DISCOUNTS / PENALTIES:

For prompt payment of 2026 taxes the following discounts are allowed:

Payments received in January 6.5% discount
Payments received in February 5.5% discount
Payments received in March 4% discount
Payments received in April 3% discount
Payments received in May 2% discount
Payments received in June 1% discount
Payments received in July .5% discount



Penalties for 2026 Tax arrears will be as follows:


August 1 (compounded monthly)	1%
September 1	1%
October 1	1%
November 1	1%
December 1	1%

On January 1, 2027 a 12% penalty will be applied to 2026 arrears

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

Tax Estimate Notices for 2026 taxes were sent in January 2026. 2026 Tax Notices will be sent mid May/ beginning of June, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.

Voyent Alert! is a community alerting service provided by the Town of Aberdeen. It is intended to keep you informed during critical incidents such as fires, or floods as well as for important day to day events such as service interruptions and facilities closures. Registration is anonymous and free. Alerts will be sent to you based on your preferred "Location" selections such as "Home", "Kids School", Office etc.

PERSONALIZED COMMUNICATIONS

Voyent Alert! provides informative communications. Critical information such as the distance and direction from an incident, and preferred evacuation routes from your tracked locations may be provided.

Voyent Alert! allows you to create and track multiple locations such as "Kids School" or "Mom's House". Any event or communication related to your tracked locations will be forwarded to you along your preferred communication channel.

COMMUNICATIONS YOUR WAY

Receive alerts over a wide variety of communication channels including mobile apps, text/SMS alerting, email or voice dial. You can register for one or more communication channels.

NO MESSAGE FATIGUE

Smart alerting capabilities ensure that you will only get notified when a communication is relevant to your or one of the locations you are tracking.

Ancient Roots & Roman Festivals

Lupercalia: An ancient Roman fertility festival held February 13-15th , involving rituals to promote fertility and purification, later Christianized by Pope Gelasius I as St. Valentine's Day in the 5th century.

Martyr: The day honors Christian martyr named Valentine, executed by Emperor Claudius II, for defying the ban on soldiers marrying.

Medieval Romance & Poetry

First Valentine: The oldest known valentine is a poem from 1415 by Charles, Duke of Orleans, written to his wife while imprisoned.

Modern Traditions & Commercialization

Handmade Cards: Early valentines in Europe and Britain were elaborate, handmade tokens with ribbons and lace,

Commercial Boom: By the 1800s, mass-produced cards became common in North America, leading to today's tradition of exchanging cards, flowers (especially roses), chocolates, and gifts, influenced by advertising and retailers.

Aberdeen First Responders

Without the support of our community, attending calls and training would be difficult. We graciously **THANK EACH AND EVERY PERSON & BUSINESS** that contributes to AFR. Our Light the Tree Campaign for 2025 raised \$633.

Aberdeen currently has 9 Medical First Responders located throughout the Town and RM of Aberdeen and will soon be welcoming 3 more Medical First Responders that have completed their training.

In 2025, Aberdeen First Responders attended over 35 Medical calls – during all hours of day and night. We treated over 37 patients and responded to calls of all ailments – from flu to motor vehicle accidents.

Did you know that Aberdeen First Responders (AFR) also respond to Aberdeen & District Fire & Rescue (ADFR) calls? We do, in fact in 2025 – AFRs responded to over 20 fire calls.

The Saskatchewan Health Authority's Medical First Responders (MFR's) are locally trained volunteers who respond to emergency calls. The MFR's are dedicated, reliable and trusted leaders/mentors who have accepted the responsibility of caring for neighbors and community members while waiting for the ambulance to arrive.

Medical First Responders complete a 44-hour course to build skills and understanding of processes and obligations. They continue their learning throughout their volunteer career.

Medical First Responders continue to be activated exclusively through 9-1-1 emergency dispatch system. This ensures a rapid response and appropriate resource allocation. Responders do not accept personal calls or direct requests for assistance.

The Aberdeen Seniors Center is available to rent for gatherings and meetings or birthday parties and anniversaries, etc.

Maximum capacity is 40 people. The building is air conditioned.
\$50.00 a day includes: full use of the kitchen (fridge, stove, dishwasher, coffee maker, dishes)




