Assessment Notices

2024 Assessment Notices were mailed out **April 16th, 2024**.

Please note that revaluations on properties are done every four years. The last revaluation was done in **2021**. The next revaluation will be in **2025**. Unless you have made significant changes to your property in the past year (ex. adding/removing a building, new subdivision, etc.), **you will not receive an Assessment Notice until 2025**.

The Assessment Notice is the official notice of the assessed value of your property as determined by SAMA. Your Assessment Notice will have the appeal form on the back of the sheet. The deadline to appeal your assessment can be found on our website and Facebook page. This notice and time-frame is the only opportunity for appealing assessments during the year. If you disagree with the property value established by SAMA, there is a formal appeal process available to you. Appeals must be based on an error in your property assessment and not based on the amount of taxes paid for the property. Appeal fees will apply. Property reports may be viewed on the SAMA website. Please check our website or Facebook page for important resources.

Tax Notices

2024 Taxes will be levied in **June**. Taxes are due on or before **December 31st, 2024**. A discount of **6%** on the municipal portion of taxes is offered for payments made by **July 31st**, **4%** by **August 31st**, and **2%** by **September 30th**. All payments must be received or the envelope date stamped by Canada Post on or before the last day of the month.

Transfer Station

March – October hours are in effect. The Aberdeen Transfer Station is open Wednesdays and Saturdays from **10:00am until 5:00pm**. If you do not have a current Transfer Station card, please contact the office at **306-253-4312** or through email. Please check the RM of Aberdeen website for a list of accepted materials.

Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for **12 months** from the date on the permit. All expired permits must be closed in a timely manner. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM Office. Contact BuildTECH Inspections at **306-370-2824** to book your inspection.

Custom Work

Custom Work is available to Ratepayers in the RM of Aberdeen for snow removal, driveway grading, and land leveling. A Work Authorization Form is required prior to any work being done by the RM. Please visit our website for more information.

Animals Roaming at Large

Keeping animals within your property is the responsibility of the owner. If your animals are roaming within the RM, steps will be taken to detain the animals and all costs incurred in doing so will be the responsibility of the animals' owner.

Pest Control Officer

If you suspect a rat infestation on your property or on a neighbouring property, please call Denis at **306-220-8996**. Denis conducts site visits in the spring and summer months. Rat poison can be picked up at the office during regular business hours. ***please bring your own bag for poison***

Controlled Burn

The RM Council would like to remind everyone to take extreme caution while having a controlled burn. Do not forget to register your burns:

1. Register with the Municipality: call **306-253-4312** or **306-230-1603** (Adrien Hamoline – Fire Chief) after hours and weekends.
2. Register with the Provincial Fire Center at **1-866-404-4911**.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality **and** the Provincial Fire Center, you will be fined **\$1000**. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighbouring Municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have proper Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

Emergency Services

In case of an emergency, please call **911**. Ensure that you are familiar with your Civic Address and Land Location in order to aid the emergency services in a quick response time to your location.

Please notify the Municipality as soon as possible of any changes to your mailing address.

All new buildings and additions greater than 100 square feet in building area are required to meet the National Energy Code of Canada. A 3-page "Energy Efficiency Compliance" form needs to be completed and submitted with your building and development permits. This 3-page form is not required for unheated detached garages or sheds.

Building Permits

Are required prior to construction of;

All New Dwellings, Garage, Sheds – 100 sq ft & over (10x10 or larger), Decks, Additions, Basement Development, Structural changes to existing buildings.

Building Permits

Are required prior to installation of solar panels on existing roof structures

WHAT'S HAPPENING

The Town of Aberdeen has applied under “Investing in Canada’s Infrastructure Program” funding for a Reservoir and Water Plant Expansion with a potential of \$3,400,000 in funding, with the Town’s share being approximately \$900,000.

We should be notified shortly if we are approved.

The main objective is to increase the potable water supply storage. Currently we have less than 1-day supply of water in case of emergency.

The reservoir expansion would give us a 3-day supply and fire flow demand with supporting a design growth potential of 1200 people. We will also receive a new Water Distribution Plant that will accommodate the reservoir expansion, with 2 pump wells, 400 m³ of storage, piping, pumps, electrical and updated mechanical controls.

Copies of the new 2024-2028 STRATEGIC PLAN are available for pick up

The **Assessment Roll** for the Town of Aberdeen has been prepared and is open for inspection in the Town Office from 9:00am to 12:00pm and 1:00pm to 5:00pm (Monday to Friday) from April 17 to May 20, 2024.

Assessment Notices have been sent to those properties with changes, either new owners or those with building permits issued in 2023. Any person who wishes to appeal his or her assessment is required to file their notice of appeal with Norsask Board Services, Board Secretary Mike Ligtermoet, 642 Agnew Street, Prince Albert, Sask. S6V 2P1, accompanied with a \$200 appeal fee for each assessment being appealed, which will be returned if the appeal is successful. Appeal deadline is May 20, 2024.

Anyone may stop by the office while the roll is open to review their assessment. If you have any questions please call 306 253-4311.

Only those residents that are new owners or have changes to their assessment due to building permits will be sent a copy of their 2024 assessment notice. Anyone else wishing to view your current assessment is welcome to do so at the Aberdeen Town Office or log on to the SAMAVIEW website.

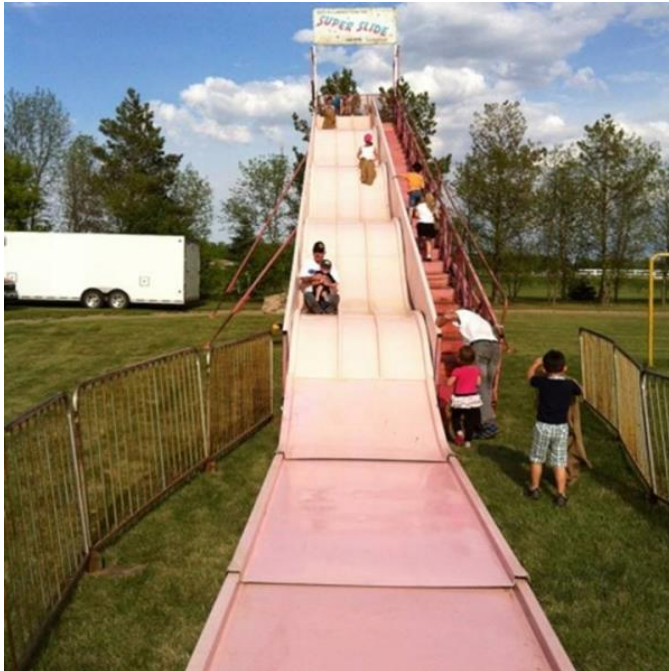

Observance: On April 28th, 2024 the Town of Aberdeen will once again recognize the Federal and Provincial Day of Mourning by lowering the flags.

It is the hope of CCOHS (Canadian Centre for Occupational Health and Safety) that the annual observance of this day will help strengthen the resolve to establish safe and healthy conditions in the workplace, and prevent further injuries, illnesses, and deaths. As much as this is a day to remember the dead, it is also a call to protect the living and make work a place where people can thrive.

The annual day for Safety and Health at work promotes the prevention of occupational injury and diseases globally. It is part of a campaign to raise awareness and intended to focus international attention on the magnitude of the problem and on how promoting and creating a safe and healthy culture in the workplace can reduce the number of work-related deaths, illnesses and injuries. Its purpose is to honor the memory of victims of occupational incidents and diseases.

While we honor the injured, the ill and the fallen workers on April 28th, we recognize the day as one for commemoration and for mobilization, we must also recognize that these injuries and fatalities can be prevented by having a strong health and safety culture in our workplaces.

- Over 100 countries recognize a world day for safety and health at work on April 28th.
- In 1988 Saskatchewan proclaimed The Victims of Workplace Injuries Day of Mourning Act.
- In 1990 the Federal Government passed the Workers Mourning Day Act.
- In 2003 the International Labour Organization (ILO) recognized the International Memorial Day to promote health and safety as a basic human right across the globe

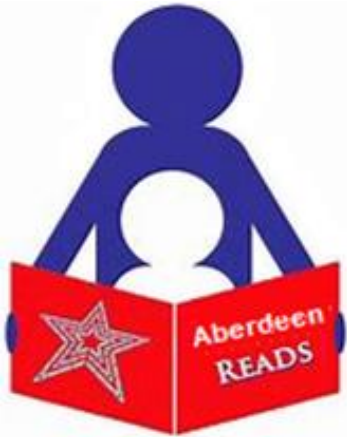
