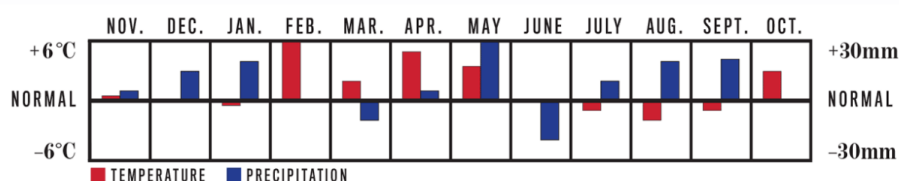

Saskatchewan Municipal Hail Association

Owners of land may withdraw all, but not part, of their cultivated land from the operations of the Municipal Hail Insurance Act by filing a withdrawal application with the Association on or before March 31st.

Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date of issue. If a permit extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM office.

It is the responsibility of the landowner to ensure that inspections are completed as per the review plan and that Building Permits are closed in a timely manner.

Call BuildTECH Inspections at 306-370-2824 to book your inspection. Covid restrictions apply to all inspections.

Taxes/ Outstanding Invoices

2021 taxes were due on or before December 31, 2021. All outstanding taxes began collecting a penalty of 1% per month.

Snow Removal

Controlled Burn

Don't forget to register your Controlled Burns

1. Register with the municipality: call **306-253-4312** or **306-230-1603 after hours and weekends.**
2. Register with the **Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.**

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have adequate Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

Pest Control Officer

As the weather turns colder, rats will be looking for a warm place to stay and a steady source of food. If you suspect a rat infestation on your property or on a neighbouring property, please call Denis, at 306-220-8996. Denis is conducting site visits and will be going around to all yard sites doing inspections. Rat poison can be picked up at the office during regular business hours.

In order for Voyent Alert to work effectively we need more residents to sign up. Currently we have 180 people participating (some of which are from the same household) which is great, 30 are still unknown to us (have signed up anonymously). We need to know who you are. Of the 285 homes & businesses this potentially leaves us with 150 properties where we would have to go door to door in case of emergency (which can take a number of hours). The Voyent Alert sends out a notification of emergency in seconds.

PLEASE for everyone's safety consider registering.

The Voyent Alert app will say "you are subscribed to receive notifications from the Town of Aberdeen using this app" but please go into the menu and look under profile to see if your name is there. If your name is not there, please add it. This step is why we have so many anonymous

2022 Business Licenses

According to Bylaw 12/14 the Business License Bylaw, all Home Based, Store Front and Contractor Business Licenses for 2021 are due December 31, 2021, and are valid until December 31, 2022.

License fees:

- Home Based Business \$25 annually
- Store Front Business \$75 annually
- Contractor \$100 annually
- General Contractor \$300 (covers the trades, as part of the building permit)

The offence for conducting business without a Business License is \$200. Bylaw Enforcement will be issuing fines for non-compliance.

SNOW CLEARING

Residents may help by clearing the front of their property where sidewalks exist. Bylaw 03/13 prohibits residents from placing any snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction, swept or cleaned from private property onto any street, sidewalk, lane, ditch, drain or sewer.

Many times, the Town Office receives calls from residents regarding the snow removal equipment depositing snow at the end of driveways. Unfortunately, this is a reality of snow plowing, and it cannot always be avoided. If you have a neighbor who is unable to remove their snow from in front of their driveway please assist them, as we often to not have the resources to go back and clear driveway approaches. We ask for your cooperation and understanding as our staff performs the work of keeping our streets open and safe during the winter.

SNOW REMOVAL PRIORITY

Snow removal will be done whenever there is an accumulation of snow on roadways from Monday thru Friday, and weekends by necessity only. Sand/gravel will be spread on streets and corners where icy, and as needed.

Priority 1 School Route – Central Avenue, Main Street, Second Avenue and Thompson Street

Priority 2 Emergency Services – Industrial Drive, Fifth Avenue South

Priority 3 Residential Streets

Priority 4 Alleys where required

Please Note; A layer of snow on roadways is not a bad thing, it helps protect the underground infrastructure such as sewer and water lines from freezing up in frigid temperatures.

Snowmobilers, please exit from point A to point B, do not cross private property when leaving the Town of Aberdeen. Keep safe, wear helmets and don't drink & drive.

The Town of Aberdeen residents will see increases beginning March 1, 2022 to our waste/recycling rates provided by Loraas Disposal. The waste/recycling rate will change from \$18. to \$21. per month. The compost rates will remain at \$10. per month for those choosing to take part in this program. The increases are passed on from Loraas, and also in part so the fees collected can come closer to covering the program expense, which has been partially subsidized by general operating monies in the past. Please contact the Town Office at (306)253-4311 should you have any questions.

The Town of Aberdeen residents will see increases beginning March 1, 2022 to our water rates. The current water rate is \$25.25 per 1000 gallons and will increase to \$26.75 per 1000 gallons. The increases are due to added costs from the City of Saskatoon and Sask. Water supply system, and also in part so the fees collected can cover the Town's utility expense. Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

Tax Estimate Notices for 2022 taxes will be sent in December 2021. 2022 Tax Notices will be sent mid May, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.

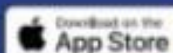
