


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Temperature and Precipitation November 2022 to October 2023

Saskatchewan Municipal Hail Insurance

Owners of land may withdraw all, but not part, of their cultivated land from the operations of the Municipal Hail Insurance Act by filing a withdrawal application with the Association on or before **March 31**st, **2023**. Withdrawal forms may be obtained from the RM Office or our website.

Garbage & Recycling Bins

If you have a rollout cart for garbage pickup, please remember to move your cart back onto your property after garbage day. Garbage carts left on the road or municipal right-of-way pose a hazard to motorists and snow-plow machinery. Our road crew cannot fully clear roads if there are obstacles on the roadway after scheduled garbage pickup. Carts damaged by passing vehicles are the sole responsibility of the owner.

Controlled Burn

The RM Council would like to remind everyone to take extreme caution while having a controlled burn. Do not forget to register your burns:

- Register with the Municipality: call 306-253-4312 or 306-230-1603 (Adrien Hamoline Fire Chief) after hours and weekends.
- Register with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, you will be fined \$1000. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighbouring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have proper Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired permits must be closed in a timely manner. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM Office. Call or text Nicole at BuildTECH Inspections at 306-370-2824 to book your inspection.

<u>Animals Roaming at Large</u>

Keeping animals within your property is the responsibility of the owner. If your animals are roaming within the RM, steps will be taken to detain the animals and all costs incurred in doing so will be the responsibility of the animals' owner.

Spring Runoff FLOOD PREVENTION for Individual Property Owners:

- Clear neighbourhood storm water catch-basins, where present, to help water drain.
- Shovel or remove snow from around your home and move it to a
 position where melt water will drain away from the foundation.
- Ensure downspouts are extended so they discharge rain or melt water a minimum distance from your home to avoid it draining back towards your foundation. The suggested minimum distance is two metres.
- Check to make sure your sump pump is working. If you don't have a sump pump consider installing one. Contact a plumber for assistance if needed.
- Consider installing a mainline Sewer Backwater Valve to protect against sewer backup.
- Keep basement sewer caps in place.

Check your basement regularly for signs of water.


Please call the office at (306)253-4311 to sign up All new buildings and additions greater than 100 square feet in building area are required to meet the National Energy Code of Canada. A 3-page "Energy Efficiency Compliance" form needs to be completed and submitted with your building and development permits. This 3-page form is not required for unheated detached garages or sheds.

Building Permits

Are required prior to construction of;

All New Dwellings, Garage, Sheds – 100 sq ft & over (10x10 or larger), Decks, Additions, Basement Development, Structural changes to existing buildings.

OptionPay: Introduction to Residents

The Town of Aberdeen is pleased to announce that it will now accept payment by VISA or MasterCard Credit or Debit card for select municipal bills/services.

Through OptionPay, our third-party payment processor, for a nominal processing fee you can make card payment through our <u>website</u> using the "Online Bill Payments" link, via <u>phone</u> to the finance group and in our <u>municipal office</u>. All processing fees are charged by OptionPay and are not received by the Municipality.

Utilizing OptionPay enables our Municipality to keep our overall payment acceptance processing costs down yet provide for individual residents to utilize their credit/debit card for payment of municipal bills/services.

Currently the following bill types for our Municipality can be paid through OptionPay:

- Property Taxes
- Water/Sewer Utilities
- Permits
- Custom Work Snow removal, Grass Cutting, Gravel
- Licenses Business, Cat/Dog
- Sign Corridor
- Tax Certificates/PID
- Tickets/Fines

All payments will be received by the Municipality within 48 business hours, so please be sure to allow for this processing time when making your payment. Also ensure to know your daily and/or transaction processing limit when making credit card payments. Credit card Rewards are earned on entire purchase, including fees.






