

## **BYLAW #7-2019**

## A BYLAW TO APPOINT BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS

The Council of the Town of Aberdeen in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
- a) "Council" means the Council of the Town of Aberdeen; and
- b) "Municipality" means the Town of Aberdeen.
- 2. Council hereby appoints Canadian Corps of Commissionaires North Saskatchewan Division as the Bylaw Enforcement Officers for the Municipality.
- 3. The appointment shall commence May 31, 2019 and shall continue at the pleasure of council.
- 4. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by Canadian Corps of Commissionaires North Saskatchewan Division, giving 30 days written notice.
- 5. The duties of the Bylaw Enforcement Officials shall be
- a) to enforce municipal bylaws 02/06 Nuisance Abatement Bylaw, 03/19 Animal Control Bylaw, 01/19 Regulate the Parking of Vehicles Bylaw, 04/14 Building Permits Bylaw, 07/14 Zoning Bylaw, 12/14 Business Bylaw and 02/19 Noise Bylaw enacted by the council of the Municipality
- b) to represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw;
- c) and other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate
- 6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on May 14, 2019.
