



## School Tax Declaration:

If, for the **2025 Tax Notices**:

1. You are an undeclared property owner who wishes to declare Separate School support;
2. You are a previously declared Separate School supporter who wishes to declare Public School support;
3. You are a previously declared Public School supporter who wishes to declare Separate School support, or;
4. A property is sold under a bona fide Agreement for Sale.

Please fill out the School Tax Declaration Form and submit to the RM Office by **February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025**. Taxes are automatically paid to the Public School, unless changed through submission of the aforementioned form.

## Assessment Notices:

Revaluations on properties are done every four years, making 2025 a revaluation year. This means **all property owners will receive an Assessment Notice in the Spring of 2025**.

The Assessment Notice is the official notice of the assessed value of your property as determined by the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA). Your Assessment Notice has the appeal form on the back of the sheet as well as the deadline for appeal. This notice and time-frame is the **only** opportunity for appealing assessments during the year.

The information contained on your Assessment Notice is used in conjunction with annual Mill Rates to determine your taxes for the year. You **cannot** appeal your taxes. You can, however, appeal the Assessment upon which your taxes are based.

# Bylaw Beat: *Business Licenses*

Bylaw No. 2022-03 - Bylaw to Classify, Regulate, and License any Direct Seller or any Business, Trade, or Calling not Assessable for the Purposes of Commercial Taxation

**Fee schedule: Part-time:** \$25.00/year or \$100/5 years      **Full-time:** \$100/year or \$400/5 years

## Zoning Bylaw – 4.14.1

Home-based businesses and farm-based businesses shall be subject to the following development standards:

- The use is clearly ancillary to the use of a farm as an agricultural operation or the dwelling unit as a private residence.
- The operator of the business is a resident of the dwelling unit and, in the case of a farm-based business only, up to two non-resident employees may be employed at the site.
- No variation in the residential or residential farm character and appearance of the dwelling, ancillary residential building, or land shall be permitted, except for permitted signs.
- All permits issued for home based businesses shall be subject to the condition that the permit may be revoked at any time if, in the opinion of Council, the conditions under which the permit was originally issued are no longer met.

## Saskatchewan Municipal Hail Insurance:

Owners of land may withdraw all, but not part, of their cultivated land from the operations of the Municipal Hail Insurance Act by filing a withdrawal application with the Association on or before **March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025**. Withdrawal forms may be obtained from the RM Office or found on our website.

The RM Office will be closed **Monday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

## COUNCIL'S CORNER

Town Council meetings are open to the public.

Council meetings are held at the TOWN OF ABERDEEN Office Chambers, 401C Main Street, at 7:00 pm every 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of the Month.

## 2025 Business Licenses

According to Bylaw 12/14 the Business License Bylaw, all Home Based, Store Front and Contractor Business Licenses for 2025 are due December 31, 2024, and are valid until December 31, 2025.

License fees:

Home Based Business \$25 annually

Store Front Business \$75 annually

Contractor \$100 annually

General Contractor \$300 (covers the trades, as part of the building permit)

The offence for conducting business without a Business License is \$200. Bylaw Enforcement will be issuing fines for non-compliance.

## It's never too early for a SNOW REMOVAL PLAN

Snow removal will be done on roadways from Monday through Friday, and weekends by necessity only. Sand/gravel will be spread on streets and corners where icy, and as needed to help diminish potential risks to our residents and vehicular traffic.

- Priority 1:** School Route – Central Avenue, Main Street, Second Avenue and Thompson Street
- Priority 2:** Emergency Services – Industrial Drive, Fifth Avenue South
- Priority 3:** Residential Streets, Main Street Sidewalk
- Priority 4:** Alleys where required.

## RESIDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

Residents may help by clearing the front of their property where sidewalks exist. Bylaw 03/13 prohibits residents from placing any snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction, swept or cleaned from private property onto any street, sidewalk, lane, ditch, drain or sewer.

The Town Office receives calls from residents regarding the snow removal equipment depositing snow at the end of driveways. Unfortunately, this is a reality of snow plowing, and it cannot always be avoided. If you have a neighbor who is unable to remove their snow from in front of their driveway please assist them, as we often do not have the resources to go back and clear driveway approaches. We ask kindly for your cooperation and understanding as our staff continue to keep our streets cleared and safe during the winter months.

## Sign Corridor

### 2025 Sign Corridor

The annual fee of \$200.00 plus GST will be billed to each sign owner to cover the cost of yearly land maintenance and must be paid by January 31 of each year. This fee has been set by council and may be scheduled to increase periodically as determined by council.

When a sign is in need of repair or replacement, the Town will send a letter to you/your business. If there has been no action to remedy the sign within two weeks of the date of the letter, the Town crew will be instructed to remove the sign from the corridor and this space in the corridor will become available to another business.

c) Signs will not be insured under Town of Aberdeen, if damages occur the sign owner is responsible to cover the costs of any repairs or replacement.

## WE NEED YOUR HELP!!!

Currently, we only have approximately 120 users signed up for our Voyent Alert System. This system would be used to provide fast and efficient notification for time sensitive information as well as emergencies.

Without more use of this system, there may be implications for the continued use of Voyent.

We are reaching out to all residents to encourage sign up of this program to ensure continuation of Voyent Alert.

## 2025 MONTHLY TAX DISCOUNTS / PENALTIES:

For prompt payment of 2025 taxes the following discounts are allowed:

- Payments received in January 6.5% discount
- Payments received in February 5.5% discount
- Payments received in March 4% discount
- Payments received in April 3% discount
- Payments received in May 2% discount
- Payments received in June 1% discount
- Payments received in July .5% discount




Penalties for 2024 Tax arrears will be as follows:

August 1 (compounded monthly)	1%
September 1	1%
October 1	1%
November 1	1%
December 1	1%
On January 1, 2025 a 12% penalty will be applied to 2024 arrears	

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

Tax Estimate Notices for 2025 taxes will be sent in January 2025. 2025 Tax Notices will be sent mid May/ beginning of June, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.



**ABERDEEN AND DISTRICT FIRE AND RESCUE**  
**A few winter safety tips from your local fire department...**

- Never leave burning candles and plugged in electric heaters unsupervised
- Check furnace filter monthly & replace filters as needed
- Never store flammable products around furnace or hot water tank.
- Ensure energy efficient furnace vents are not obstructed by any objects. Intake vents should be checked weekly for ice buildup.
- Only use clean well-seasoned (1-year) wood in wood burning stoves and fireplaces.
- Check and clean chimney regularly as needed.
- Test smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors monthly – push the test button.
- Electric heater - Check for broken insulation/cracked wiring.
- Smoke alarm and carbon monoxide batteries should be replaced yearly.
  - Smoke alarms should be replaced every 5 years
  - Carbon monoxide alarms replaced every 10 years or as per label on pkg.
- Check fire extinguisher for expiration date or low pressure.
- Talk to your local fire fighters with any questions


