

**BYLAW # 06-11
TOWN OF ABERDEEN**

A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

The Council of the Town of Aberdeen in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Council" means the Council of the Town of Aberdeen; and
 - b) "Municipality" means the Town of Aberdeen.
2. Council hereby appoints EPS Management Services Inc. as the Bylaw Enforcement Officers for the Municipality.
3. The appointment shall commence June 21, 2011 and shall continue at the pleasure of council.
4. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by EPS Management Services Inc. giving 30 days written notice.
5. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be
 - a) to enforce municipal bylaws 02/06 Nuisance Abatement Bylaw, 01/07 Animal Control Bylaw, 02/07 Dangerous Animal Bylaw and 09/07 Regulate the Parking of Vehicles Bylaw enacted by the council of the Municipality
 - b) to represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw;
 - c) and other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on June 21, 2011.
