## 2017 MONTHLY TAX DISCOUNTS / PENALTIES:

**For prompt payment of 2017 taxes the following discounts are allowed:**

Payments received in January 6.5% discount  
Payments received in February 5.5% discount  
Payments received in March 4% discount  
Payments received in April 3% discount  
Payments received in May 2% discount  
Payments received in June 1% discount  
Payments received in July .5% discount



**Penalties for 2017 Tax arrears will be as follows:**

August 1 (compounded monthly)	1%
September 1	1%
October 1	1%
November 1	1%
December 1	1%

**On January 1, 2017 a 12% penalty will be applied to 2016 arrears**

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

**Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes**

**Tax Estimate Notices for 2017 taxes will be sent in December 2016. 2017 Tax Notices will be sent mid May, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.**

## ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW – Bylaw No. 13-15

The Town of Aberdeen offers **FREE** registration in 2017 to all residents with pets (during the month of January ONLY)! All registration forms for cats and dogs must be completed OR updated if there are any changes. If you have no updates to report, you must still call in to re-register to take advantage of the incentive!

If you have not completed a registration form please contact the Town Office to obtain one. Every cat or dog must be registered annually. Please visit our website [www.aberdeen.ca](http://www.aberdeen.ca) for our restricted animals list, and schedule of fees after February 1. Our office receives numerous complaints about animals running at large. Please keep pets on your own property!

## ALL TERRAIN VEHICLE ACT

A person must be 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license to operate an ATV in any public area.

Youth between the ages of 12 and 15 can operate an ATV but cannot drive on roads/streets and must be supervised by someone who holds a driver's license. Helmets must be worn by drivers and passengers at all times.

No person shall operate an ATV:

- (a) on any private land; or
- (b) on any road/street or any portion thereof within town limits, except for the purpose of crossing the said roads / streets to the closest point of exit;
- (c) any municipal land in the municipality; and
- (d) must not operate between the hours of 10:30pm and 7:00am.
