

TOWN OF ABERDEEN

BYLAW NO. 05-2014

A BYLAW IN THE TOWN OF ABERDEEN, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO APPOINT PREDATOR CONTROL OFFICER(S).

The Council of the Town of Aberdeen, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Council of the Town of Aberdeen is hereby authorized to appoint Ryan White for the Town of Aberdeen.
2. The appointment shall be terminated by either the Council of the Town of Aberdeen, or the officer.
3. The Predator Control Officer will follow the guidelines listed below in eliminating crows or other animals that are creating a nuisance in the community.
 - (a) In residential areas shooting crows or other animals shall not occur between dusk and 7:00 am, unless the animal is judged to be an immediate danger to the public.
 - (b) Permission from the property owner must be obtained prior to entering property.
 - (c) Birds are not to be shot in flight.
 - (d) The dead crows or other animals must be disposed of at the landfill.
 - (e) The Predator Control Officer shall be allowed to use an air rifle or .22 caliber rifle in residential areas. He/She shall also be allowed to use a 12 gauge shotgun in more secluded or wooded areas.
 - (f) The Predator Control Officer shall be reimbursed for bullets and any landfill disposal fees upon submission of invoices.
 - (g) At the end of the year, an honorarium of \$250.00 shall be paid to the Predator Control Officer(s).
4. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval of Council.
