Currently the ARC Fire Suppression System is not meeting the requirements for pressure for insurance purposes. Would like clarification as to whether there is something the Town can do or if the new plant will rectify the lack of pressure. Brad discussed being told the next time a test is going to be performed. The standby pump at the Water Pumphouse can be turned on to avoid the drop in pressure that currently occurs before the pump kicks in. This may not solve the issue but is worth a try. The construction of the new WPH increases the capacity from approximately 20Ls to 75.6Ls which should provide the required pressure. Will contact engineers to confirm.
